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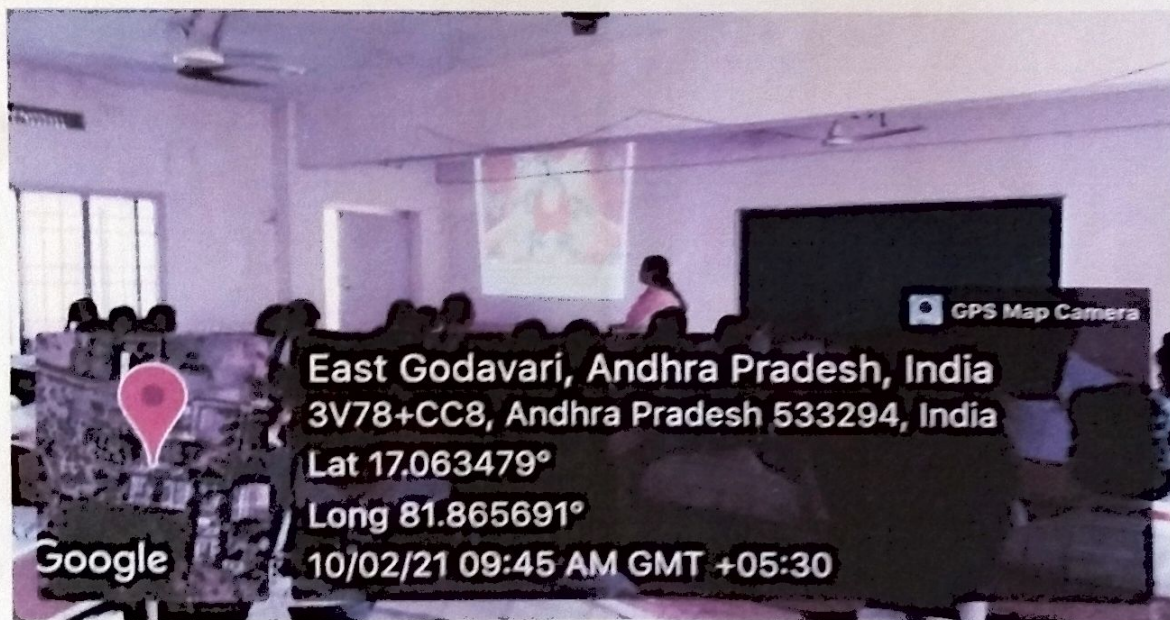
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Outcome of the program

Design of experiments is a way to intelligently form framework to decide which is the cause of action you might take. They also include to gain reliable, valid information. A designed experiment aims to eliminate sources of bias such bias that would occur from testing an intervention in subjects who are undergoing developments in their condition. It also aims to manage confounding variables that would decrease accuracy of results.

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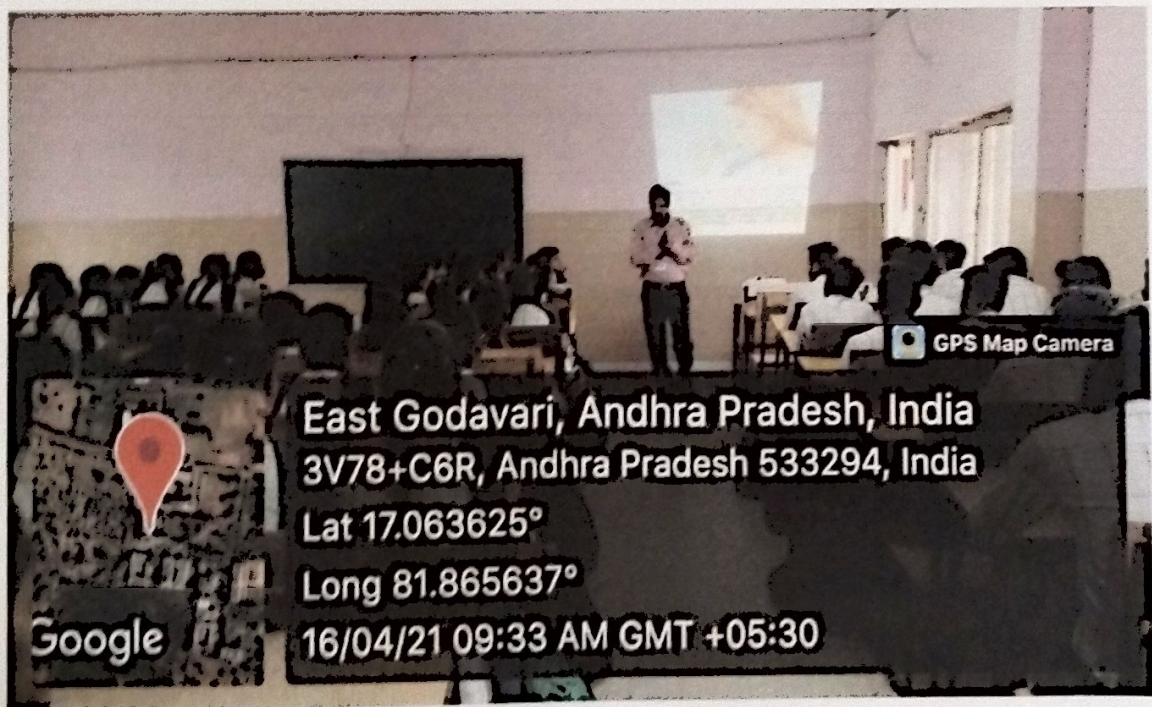

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
Outcome of the program

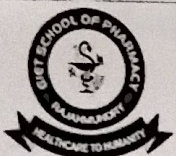
