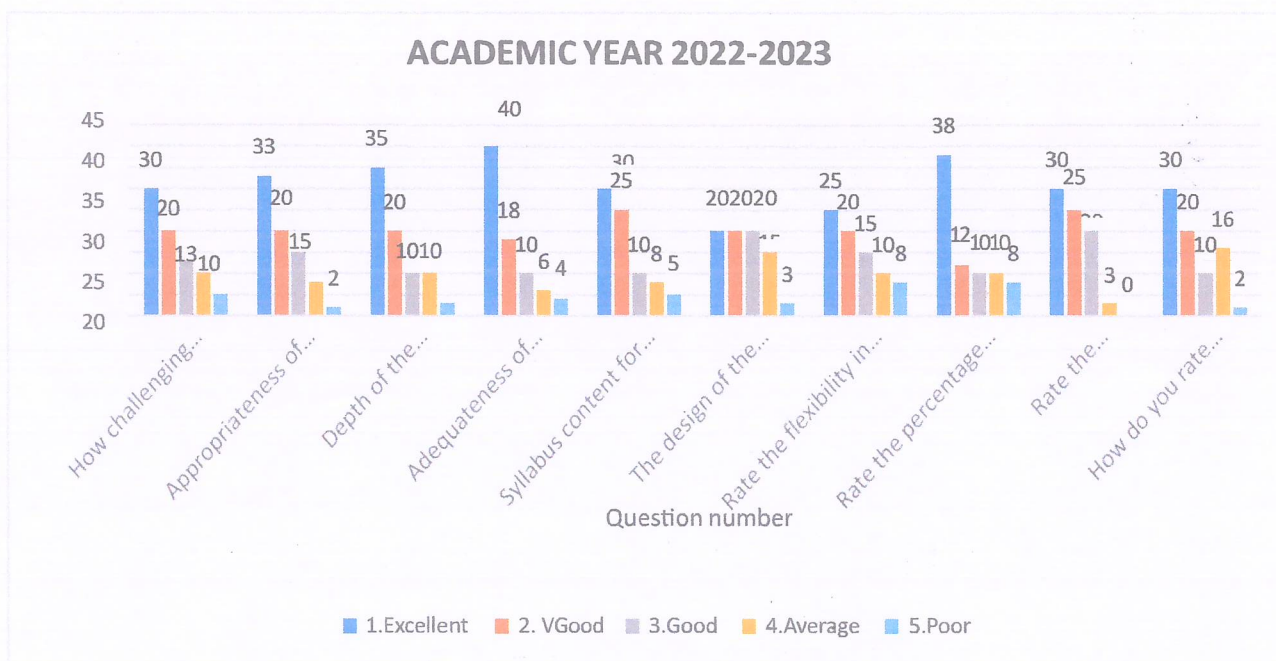
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## STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

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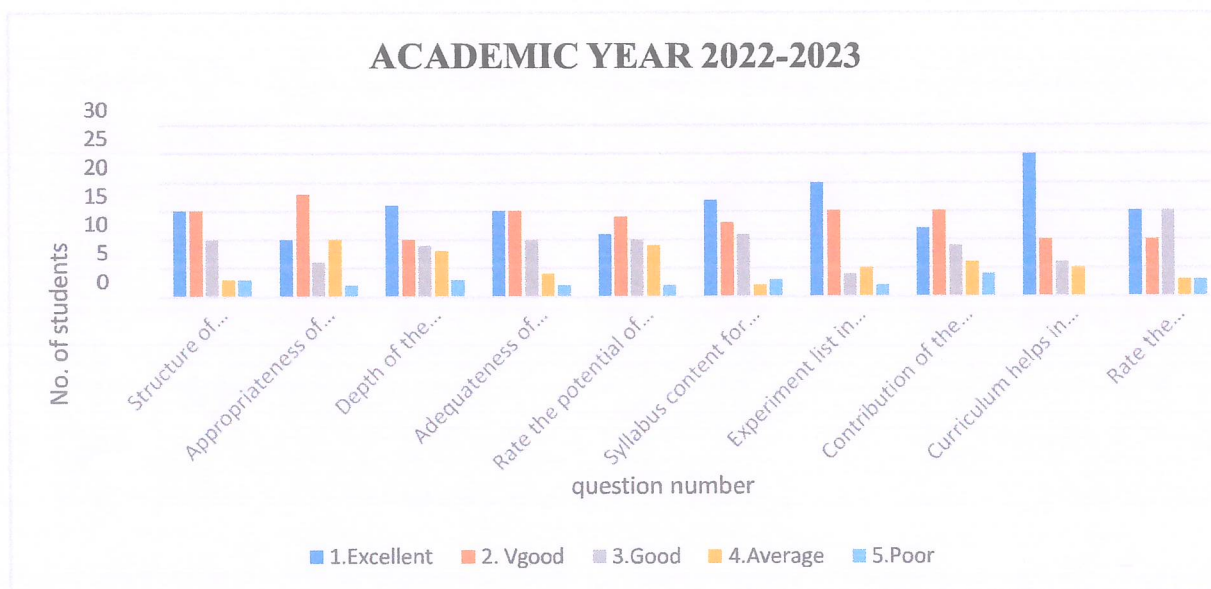
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## TEACHERS FEED BACK ANALYSIS FOR ACDEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

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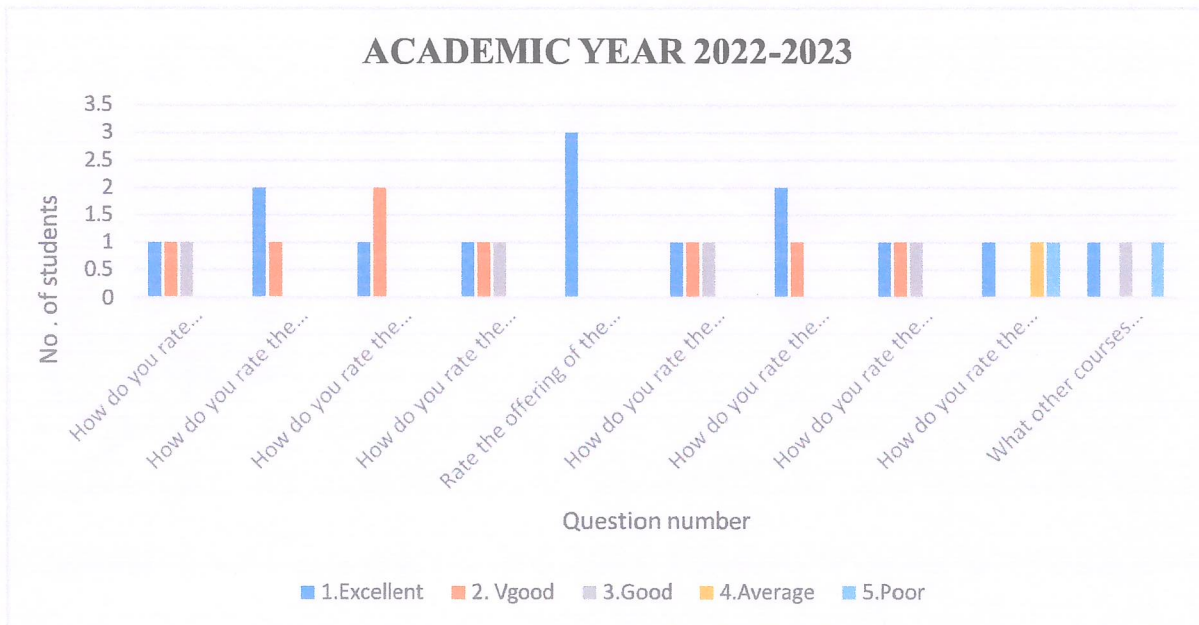

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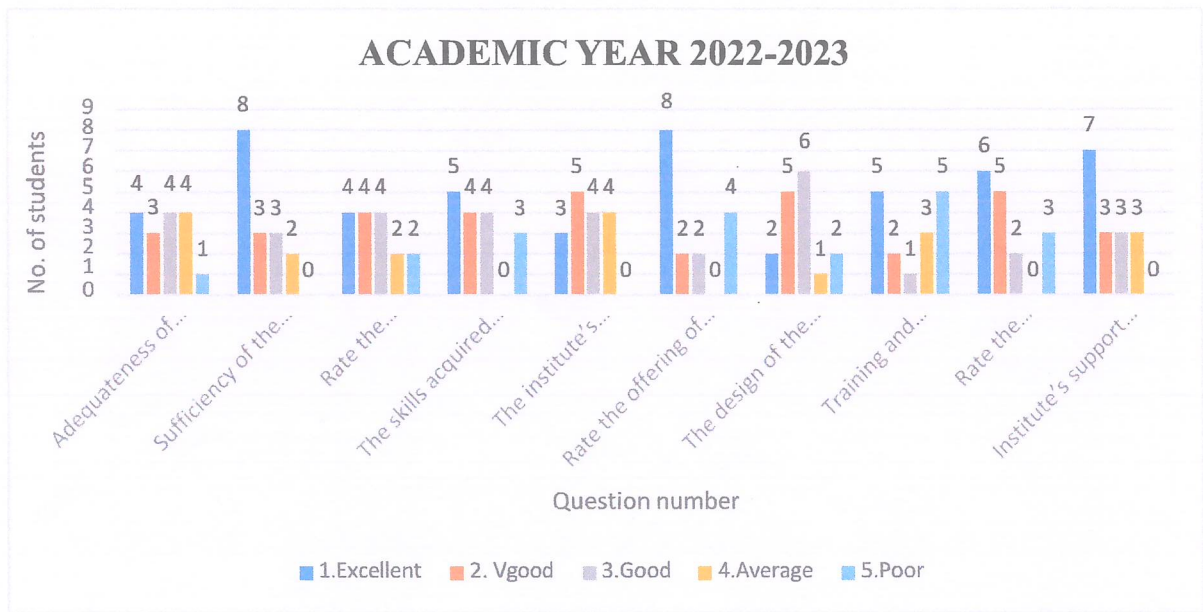

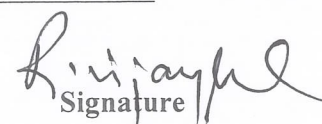
