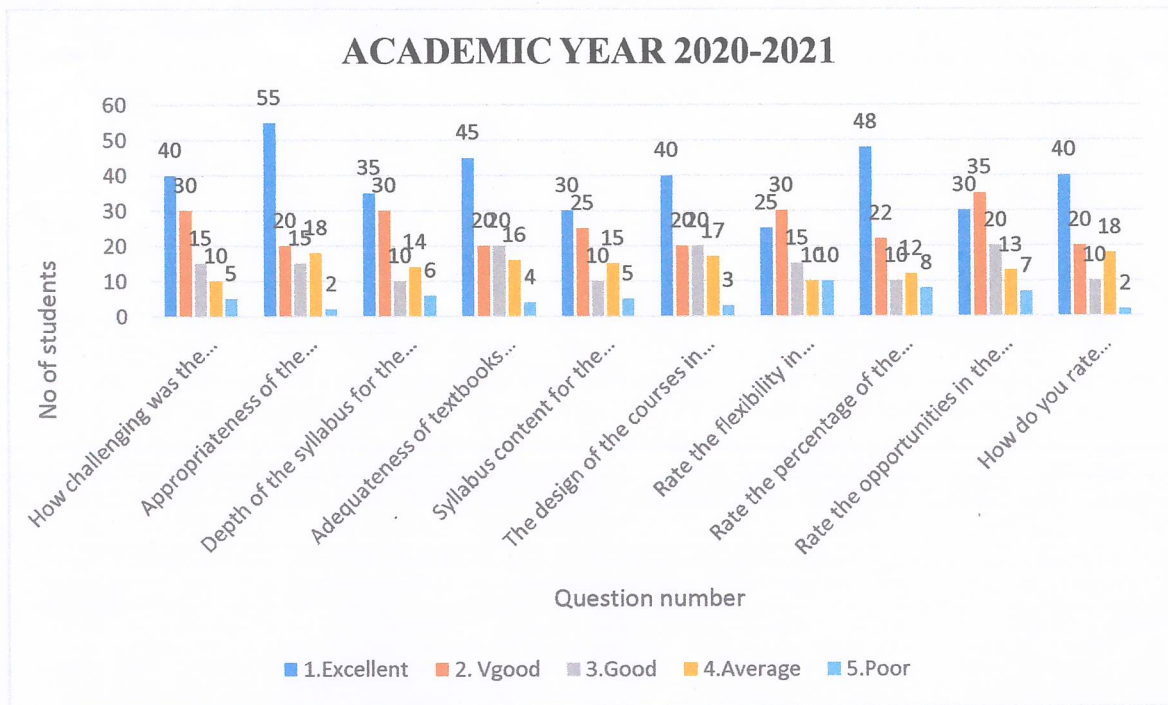
ACTION TAKEN REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021 STUDENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

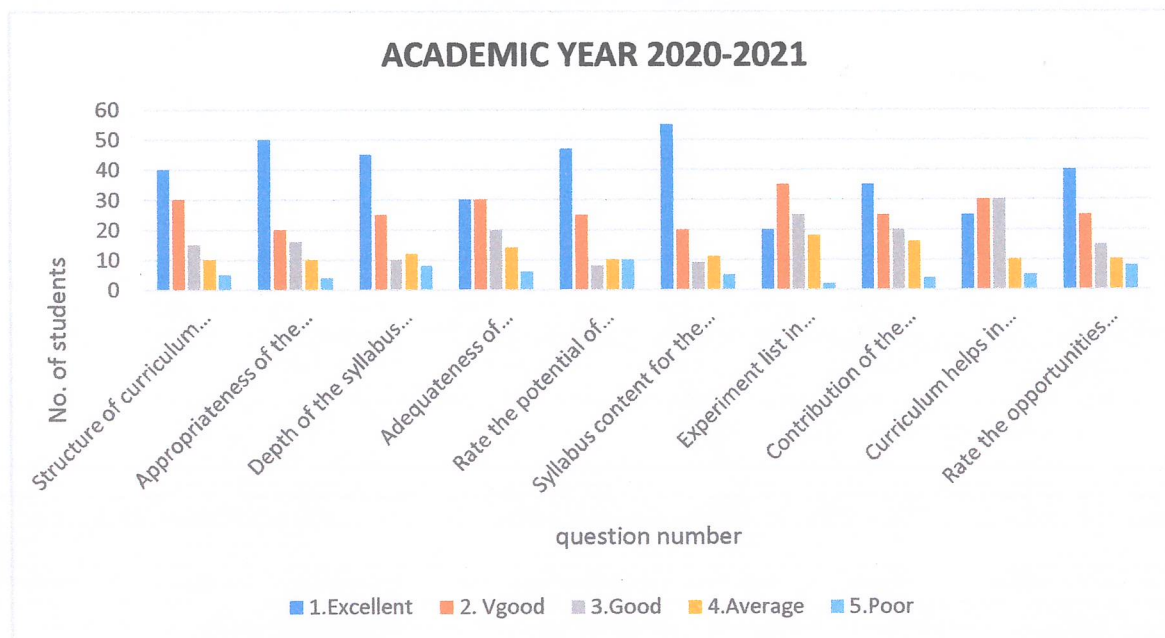
TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM



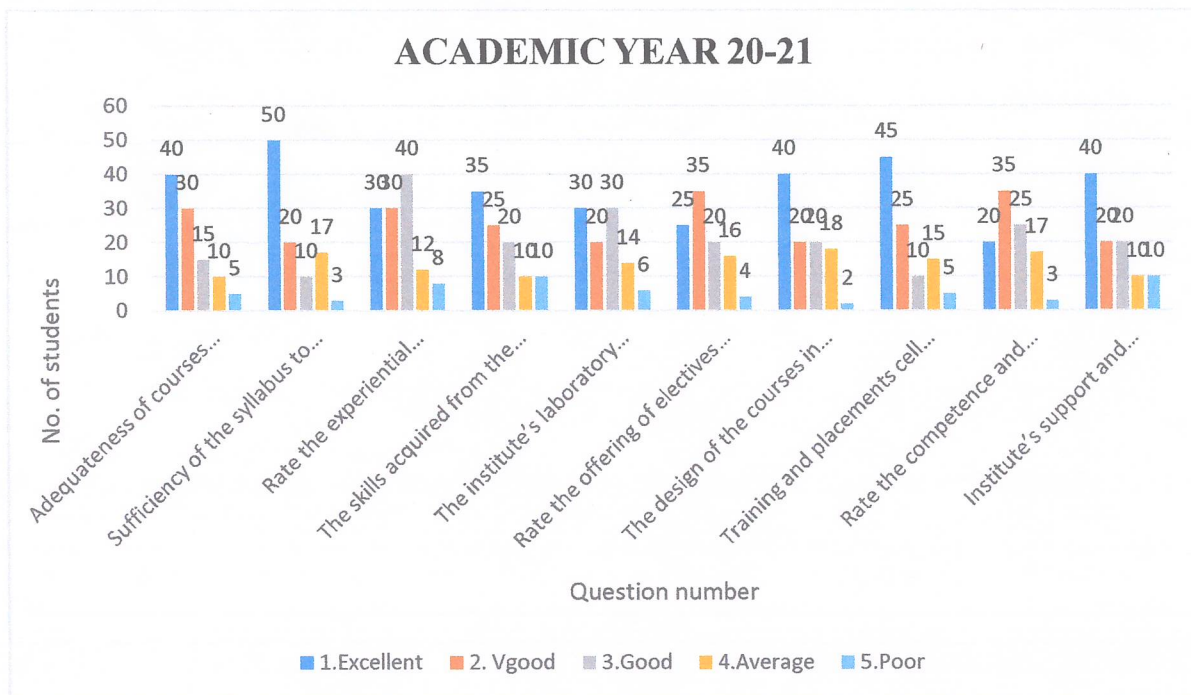

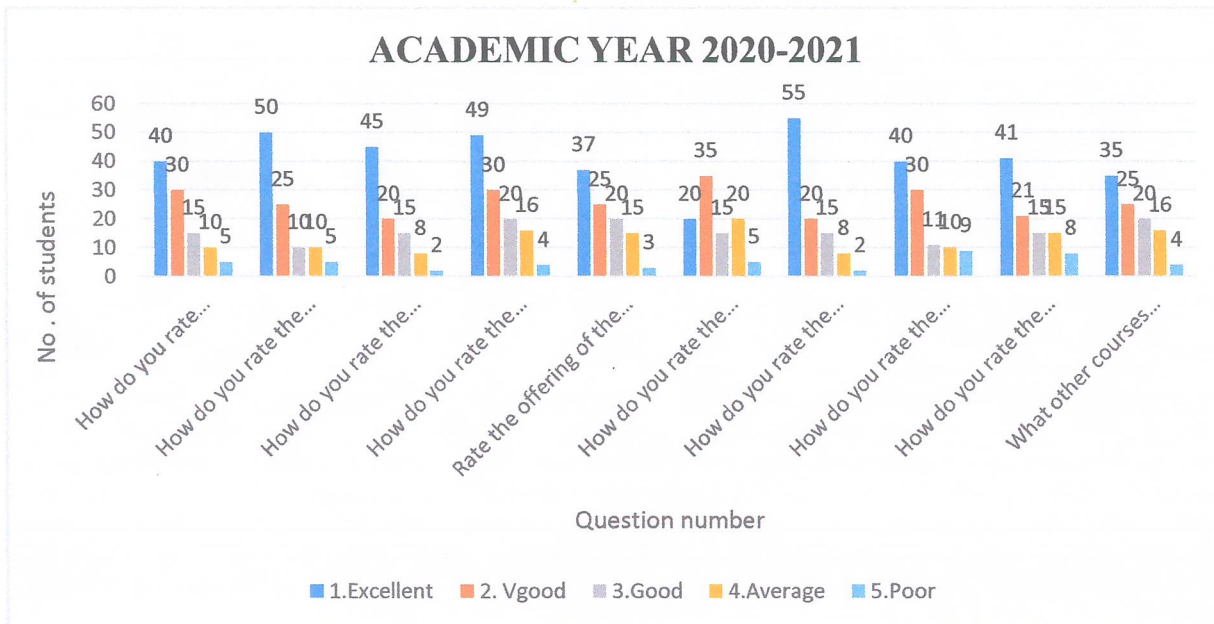
