

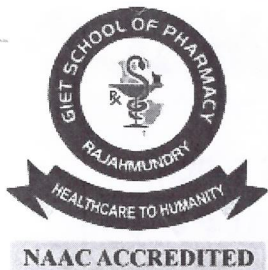

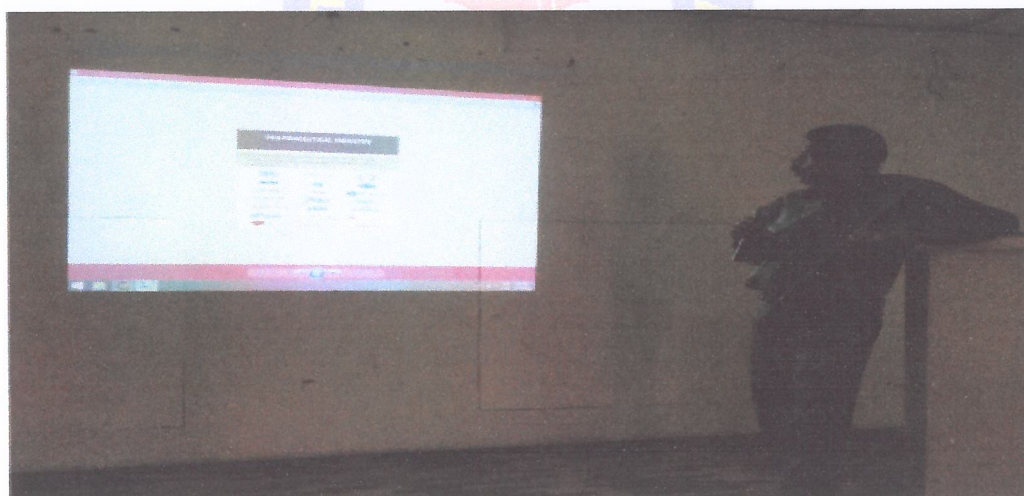


Fig. 2: Presentation on Pharmaceutical Industries in India

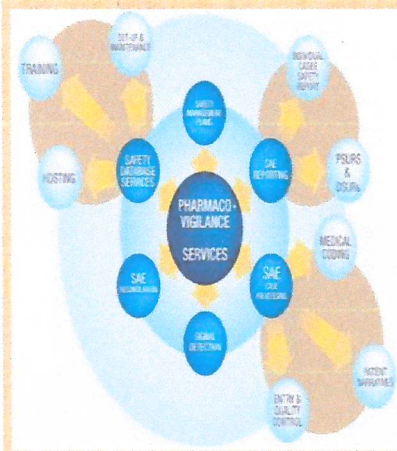

Pharmacovigilance(PV): Pharmacovigilance can be defined as the science and activities concerned with the detection, assessment, understanding and prevention of adverse reactions to medicines (i.e. adverse drug reactions or ADRs).

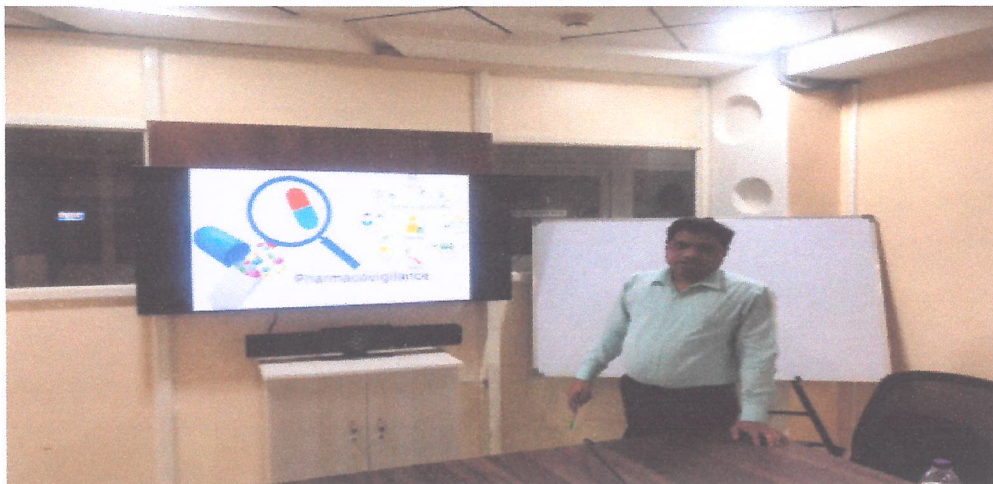


Fig. 1: Presentation on Pharmacovigilance and drug development

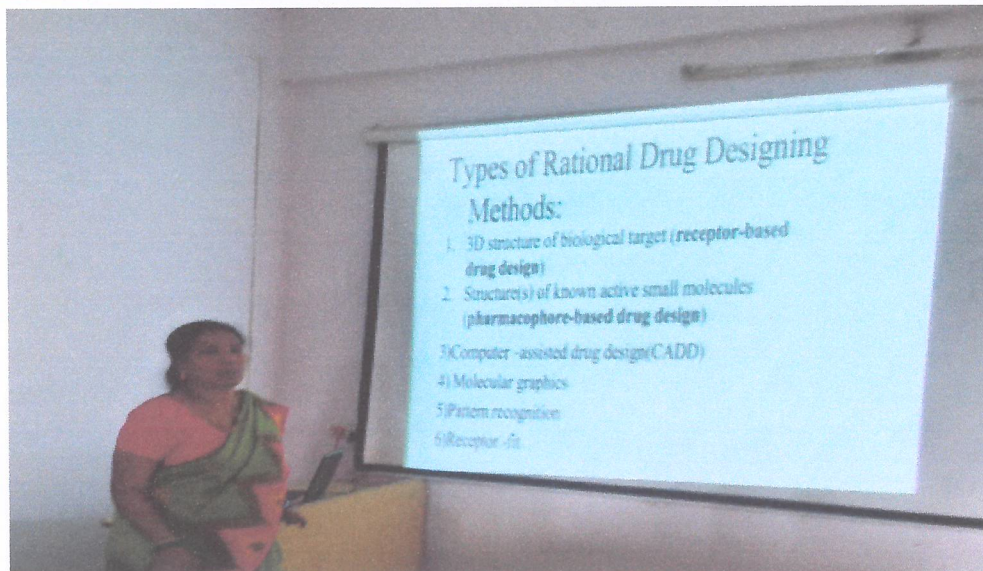


Fig. 1: Presentation on Drug Research using Rational drug design

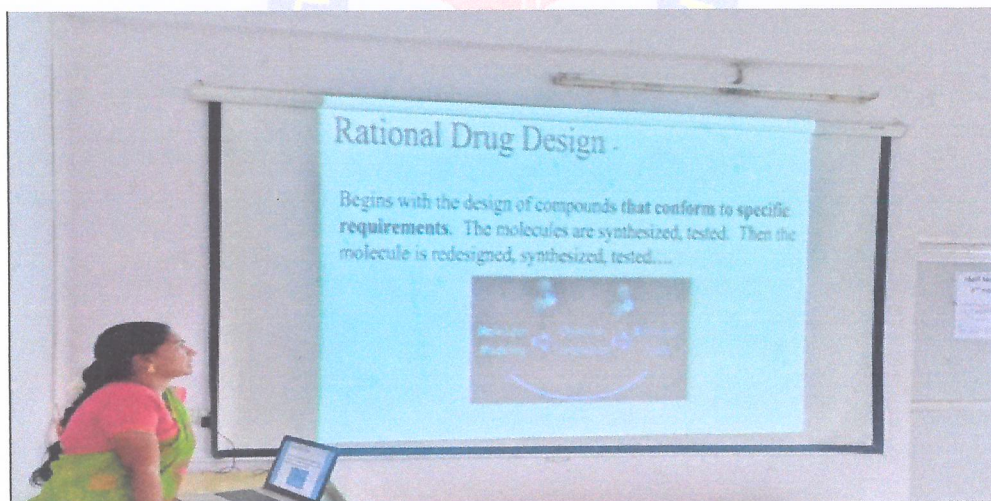


Fig. 2: Presentation on Drug Research using Rational drug design.



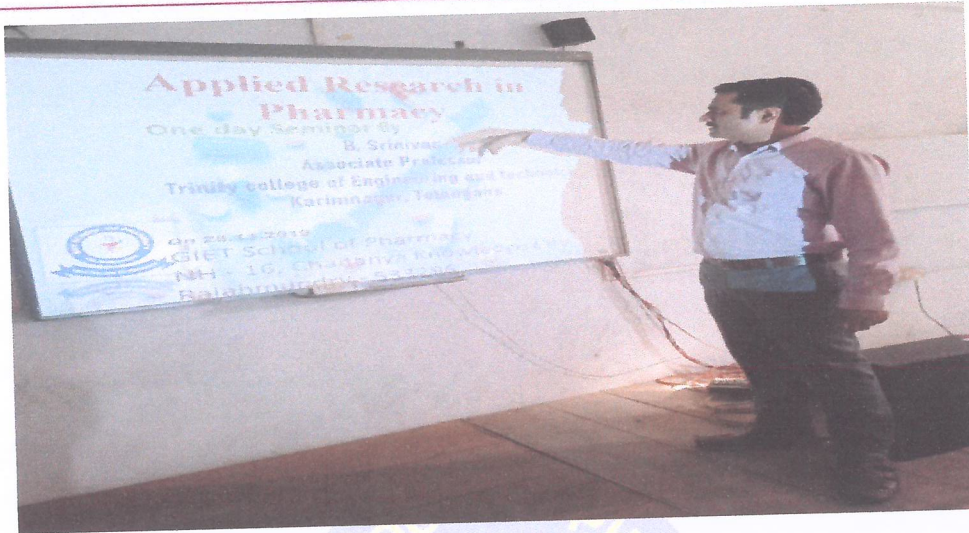


Fig. 1: Presentation on applied research in pharmacy

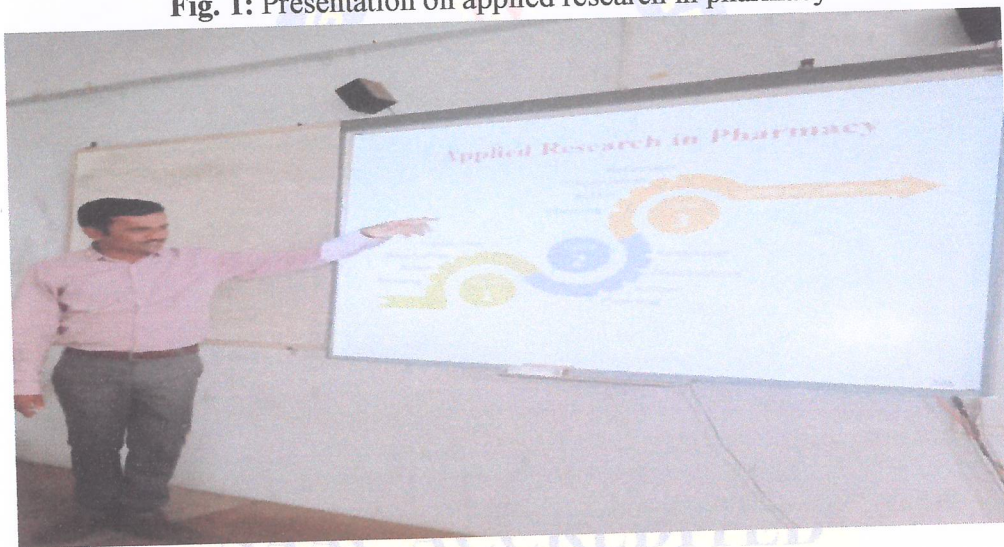


Fig. 2: Presentation on applied research in pharmacy




Fig. 2: Presentation on Scope of Pharmacy Profession and making a new entrepreneur

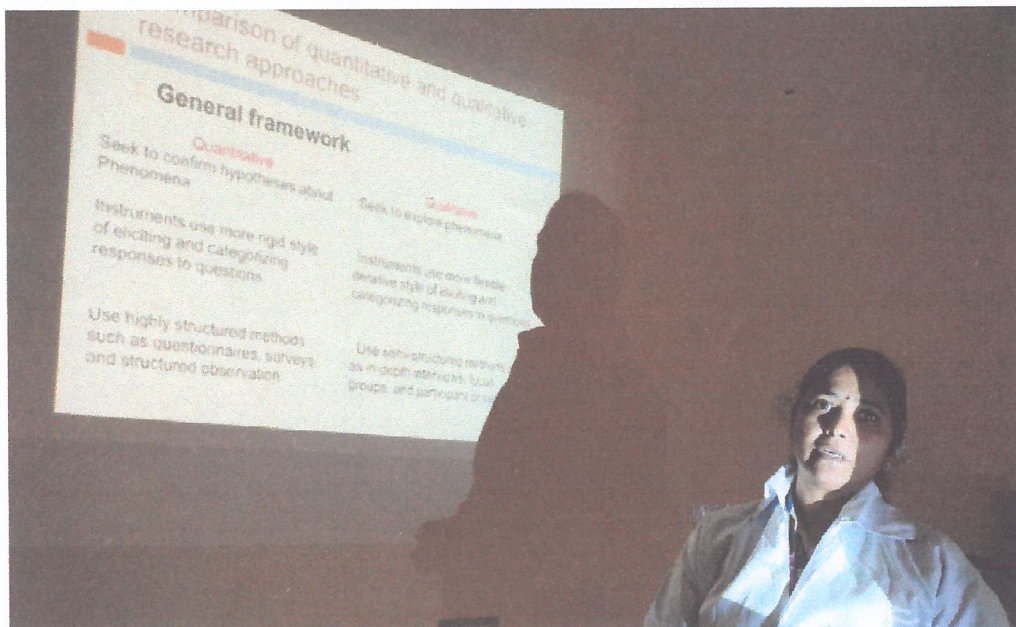


Fig. 1: Presentation on Qualitative research

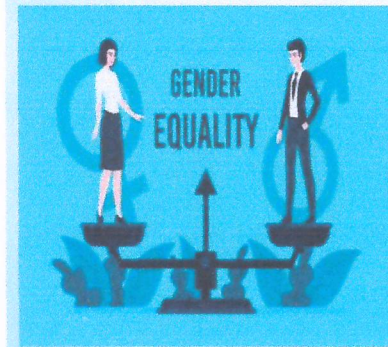

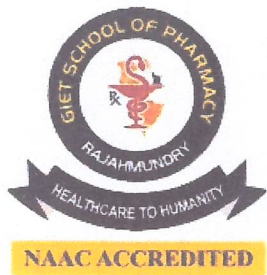

One-day seminar on “**Women rights and gender equality**” at GIET School of Pharmacy

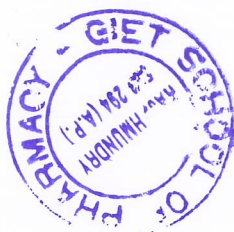

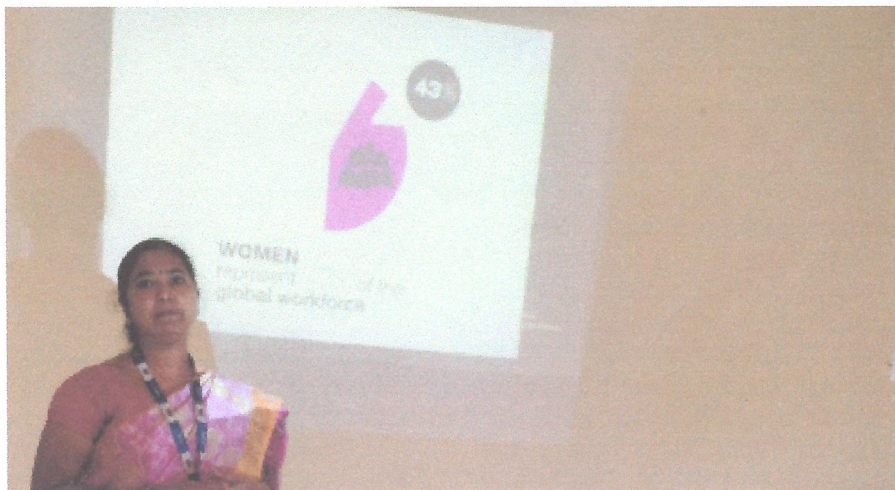


Fig. 1: Presentation of Women rights and gender equality

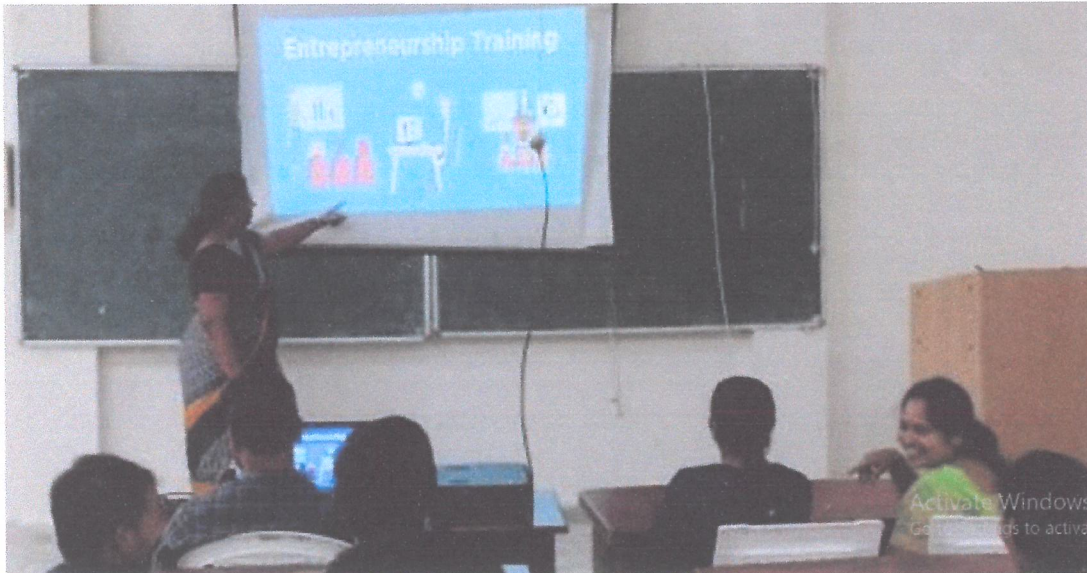


Fig. 1: Presentation of Entrepreneurial training

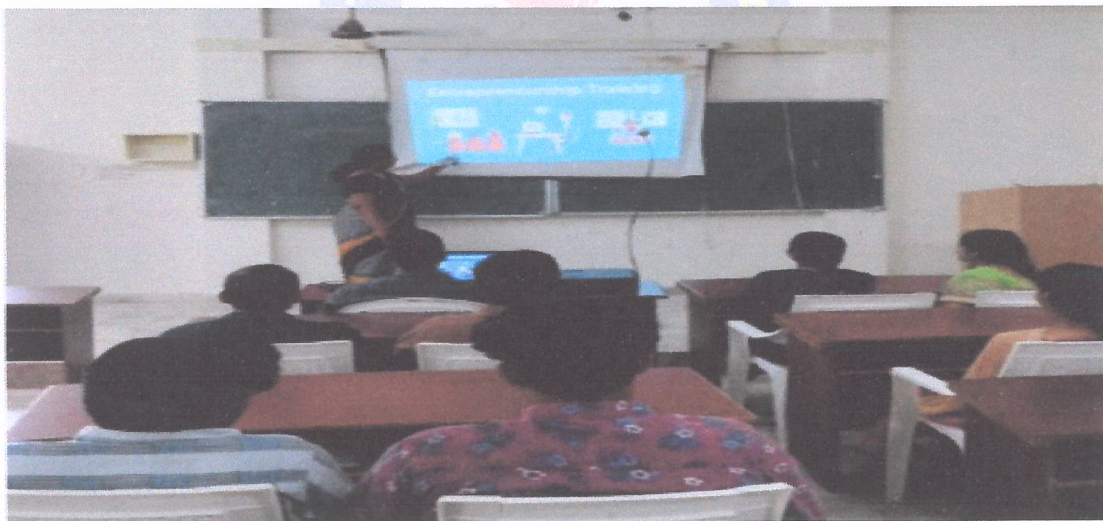


Fig. 2: Presentation of Entrepreneurial training
