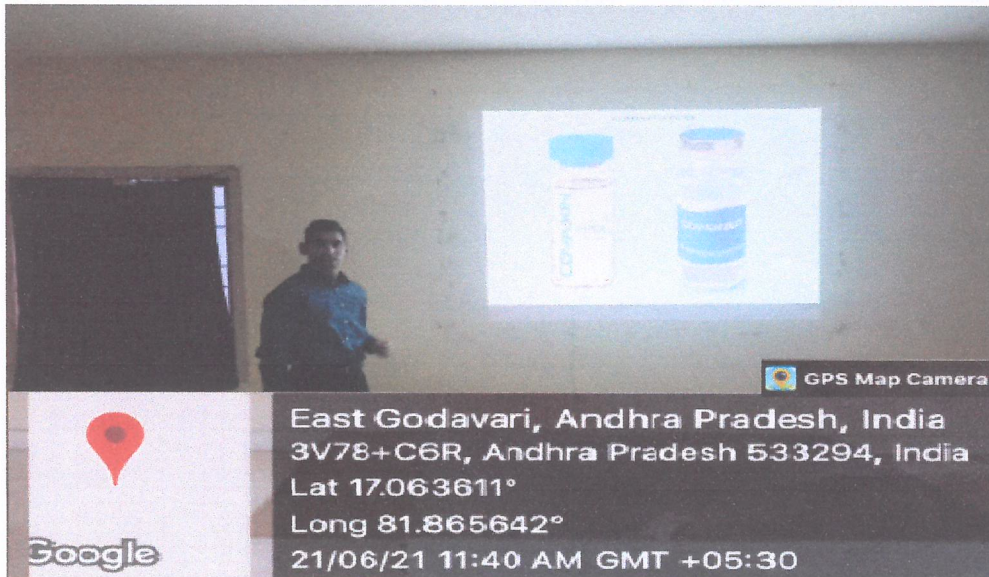


Fig. 1: Presentation on “Research on Corona Vaccine”

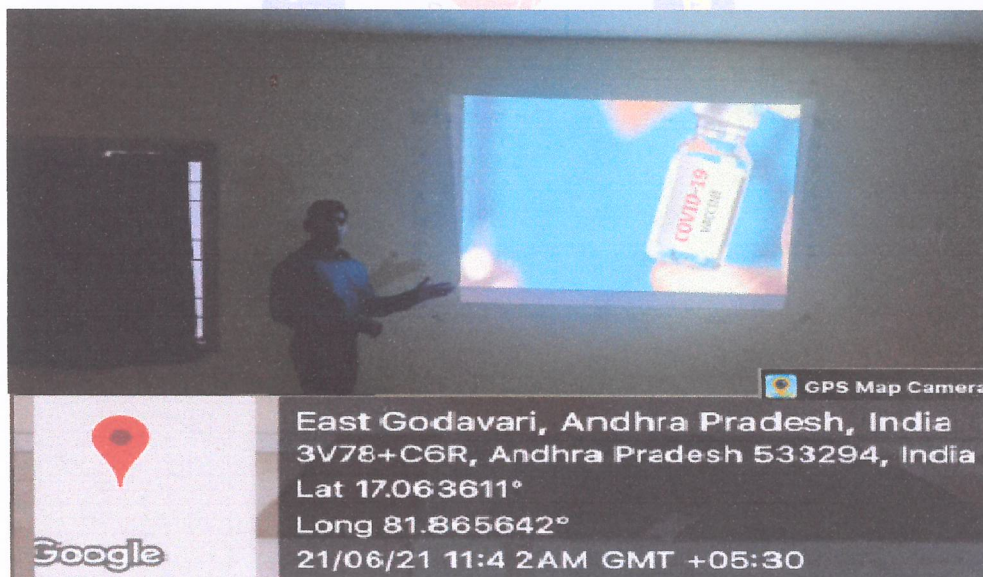


Fig. 2: Presentation on “Research on Corona Vaccine”

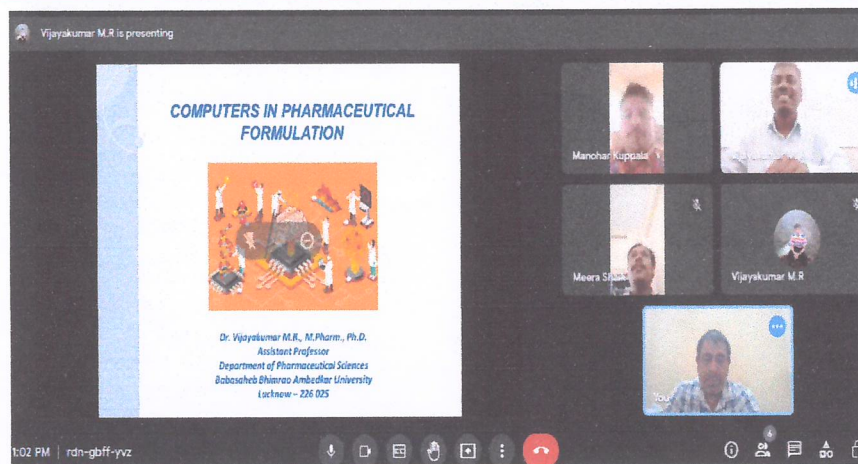


Fig. 1: Presentation on Computers in Pharmaceutical Formulations and its research

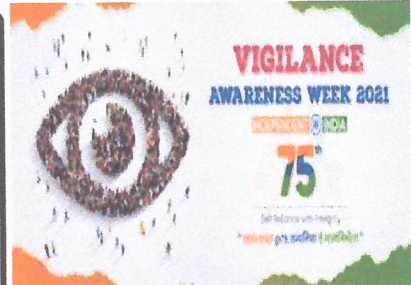

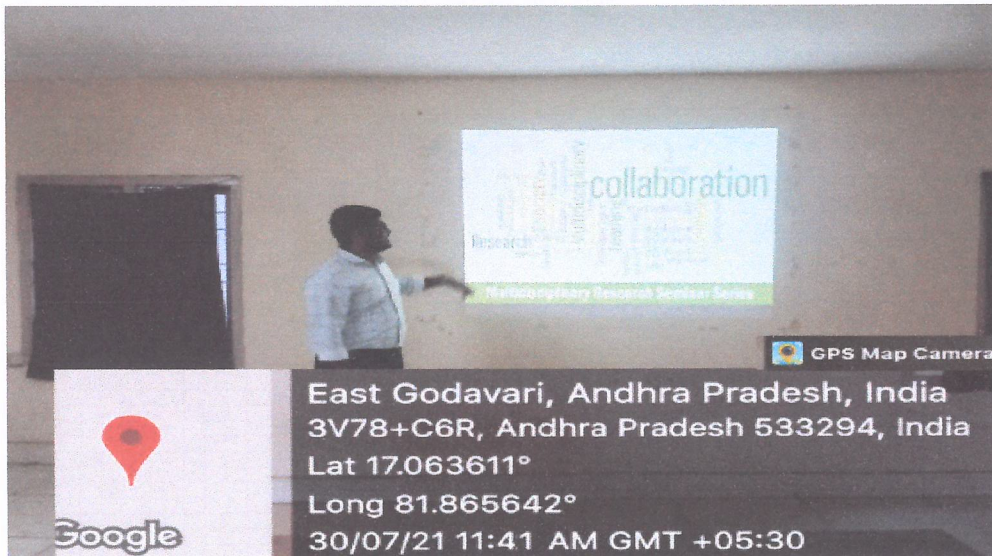


Fig. 1: Presentation on Multidisciplinary research

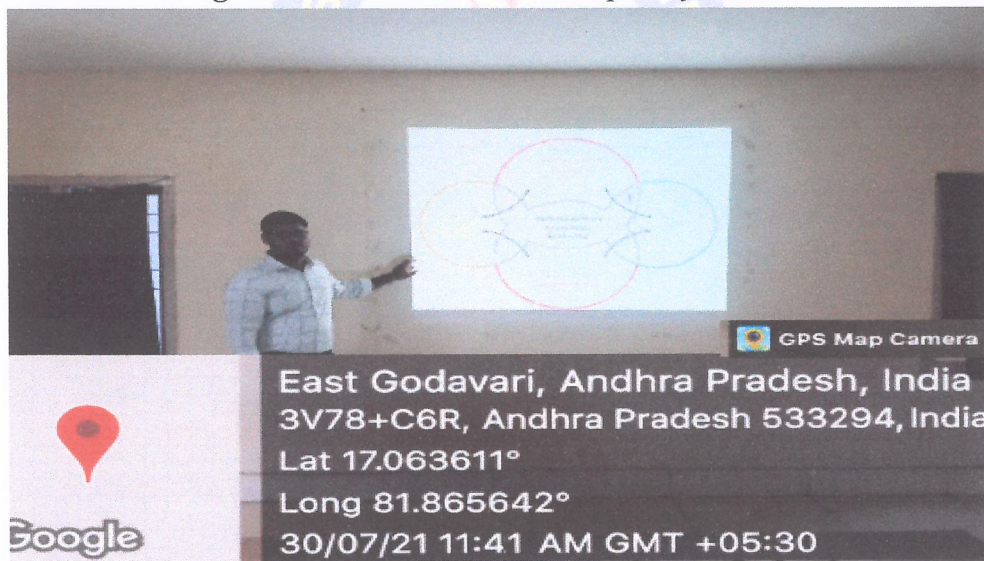


Fig. 2: Presentation on Multidisciplinary research

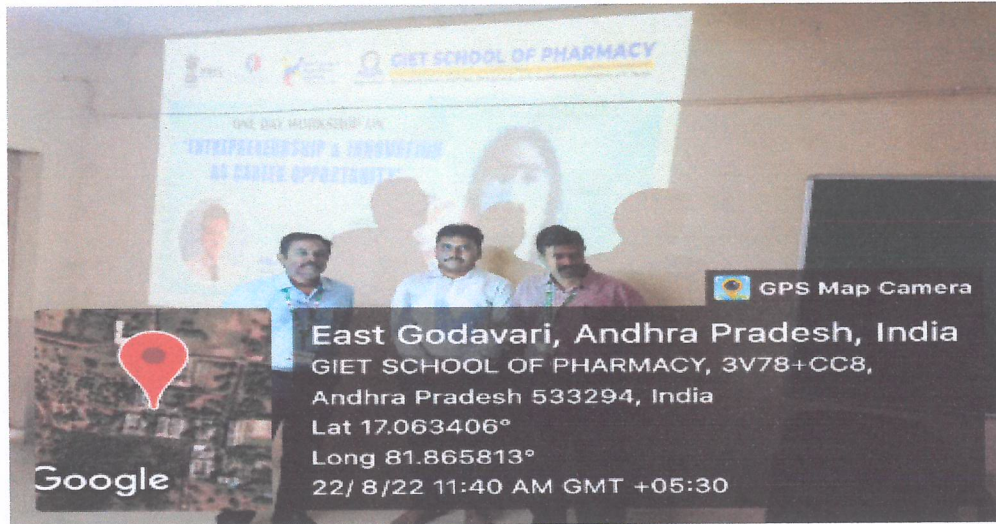


Fig. 1: Presentation on Entrepreneurship & Innovation as career opportunity

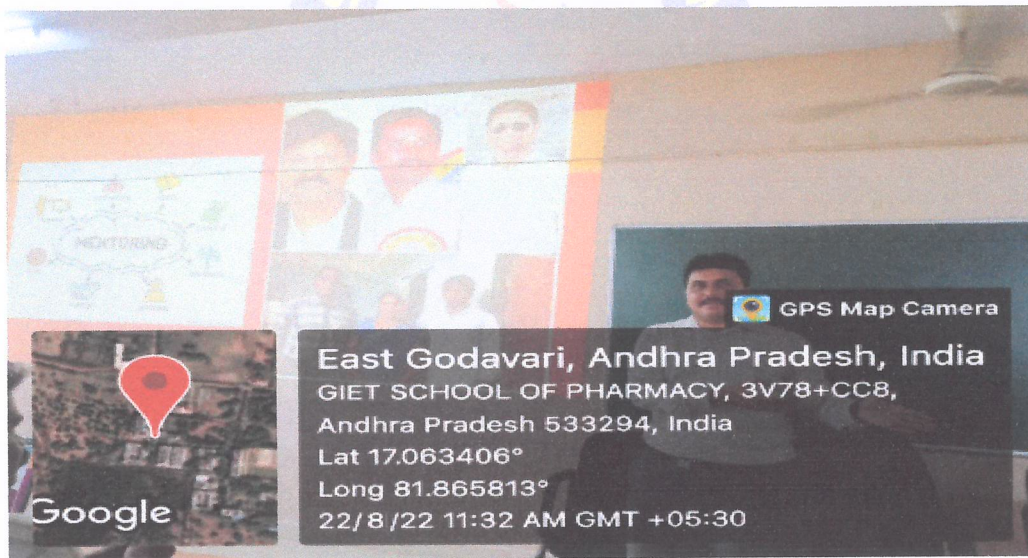


Fig. 2: Presentation on Entrepreneurship & Innovation as career opportunity



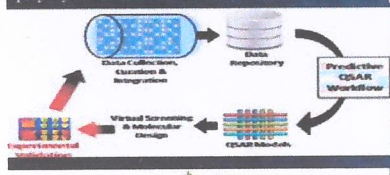

- (iv) application of QSAR model to predict the biological property for the molecules

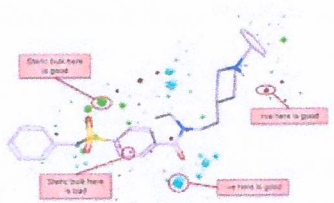
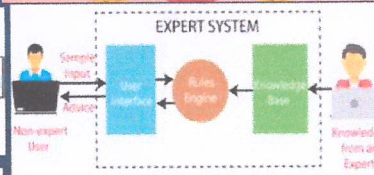
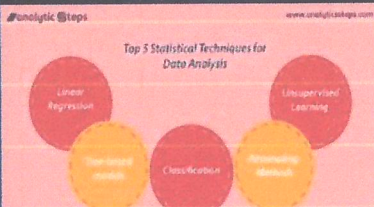

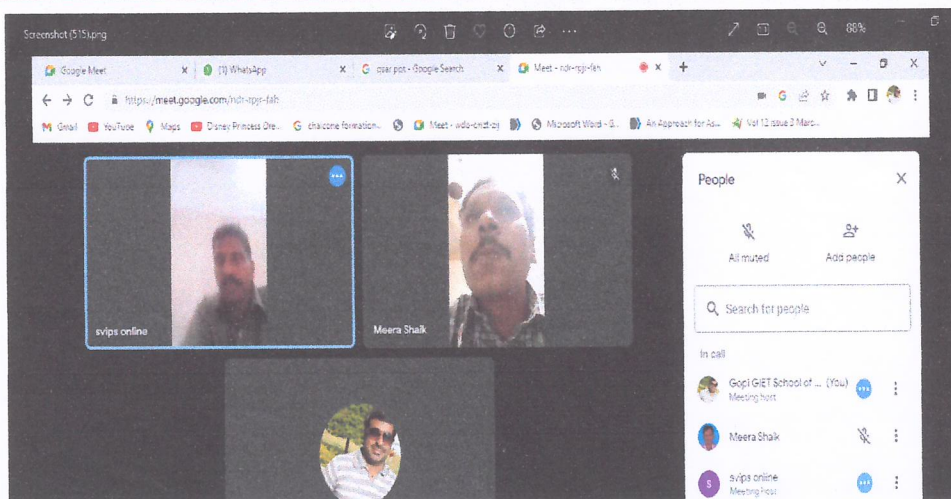


Fig. 1: Presentation on Drug design research: QSAR

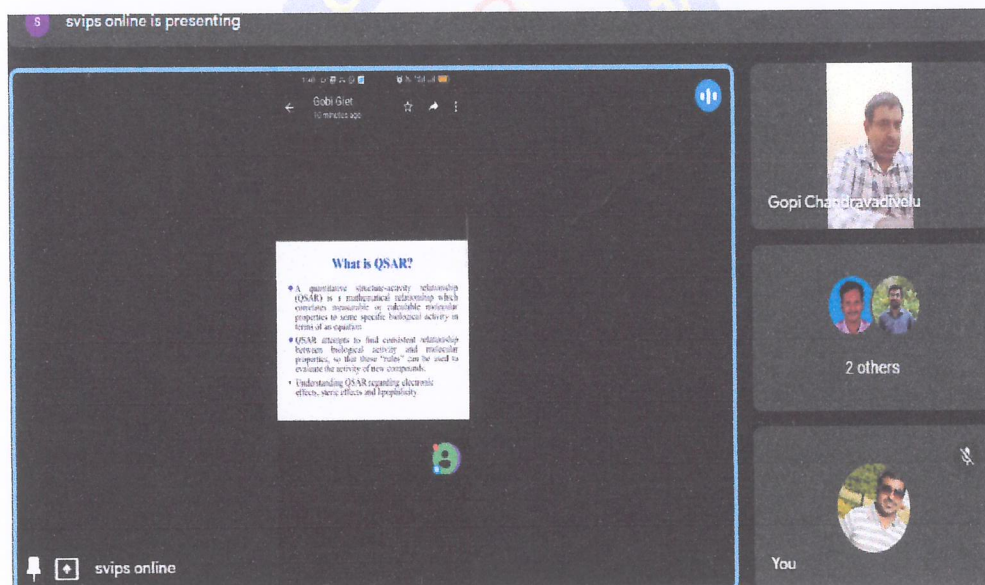


Fig. 2: Presentation on Drug design research: QSAR

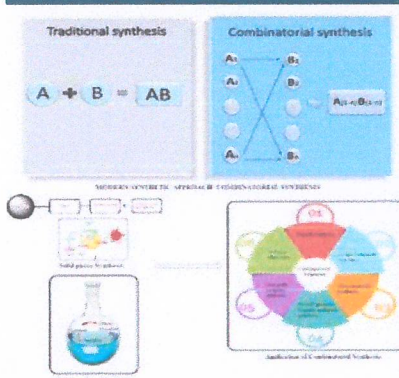

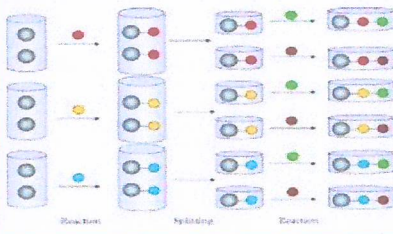

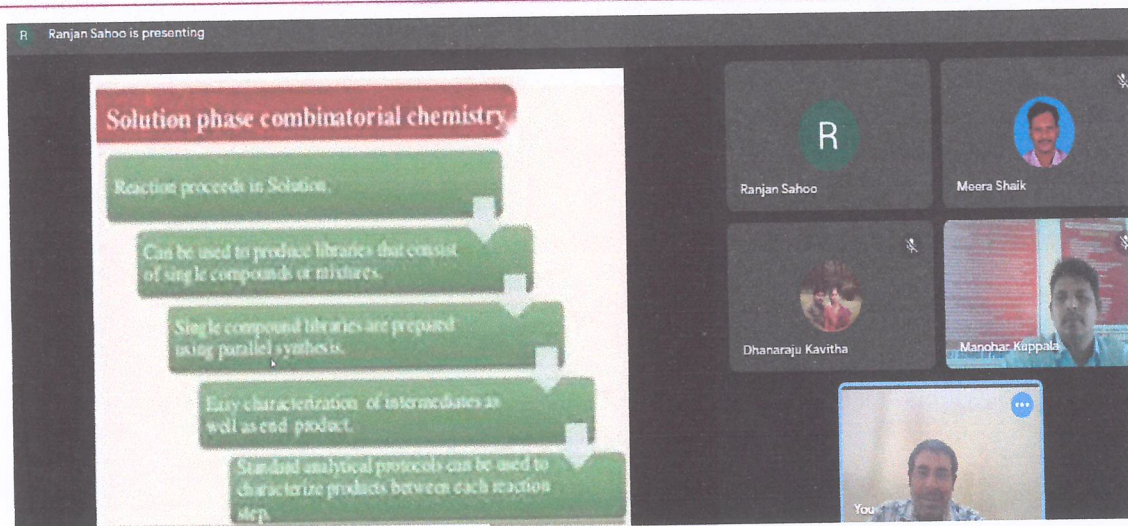


Fig. 1: Presentation on combinatorial synthesis and its research

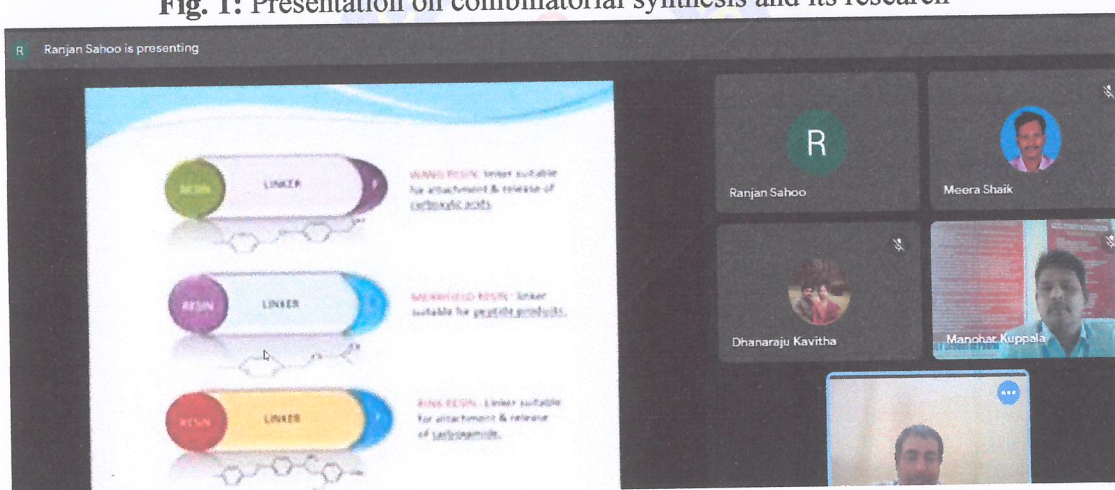


Fig. 2: Presentation on combinatorial synthesis and its research

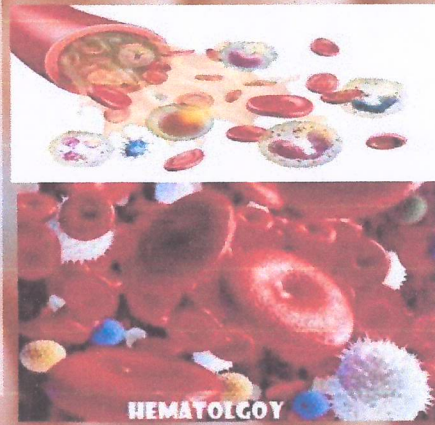

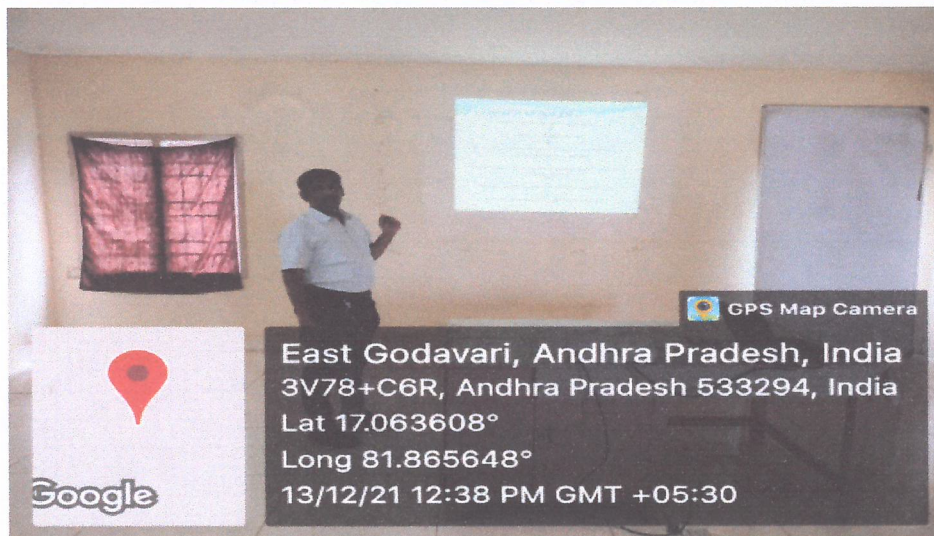


Fig. 1: Presentation on Clinical research in Hematology

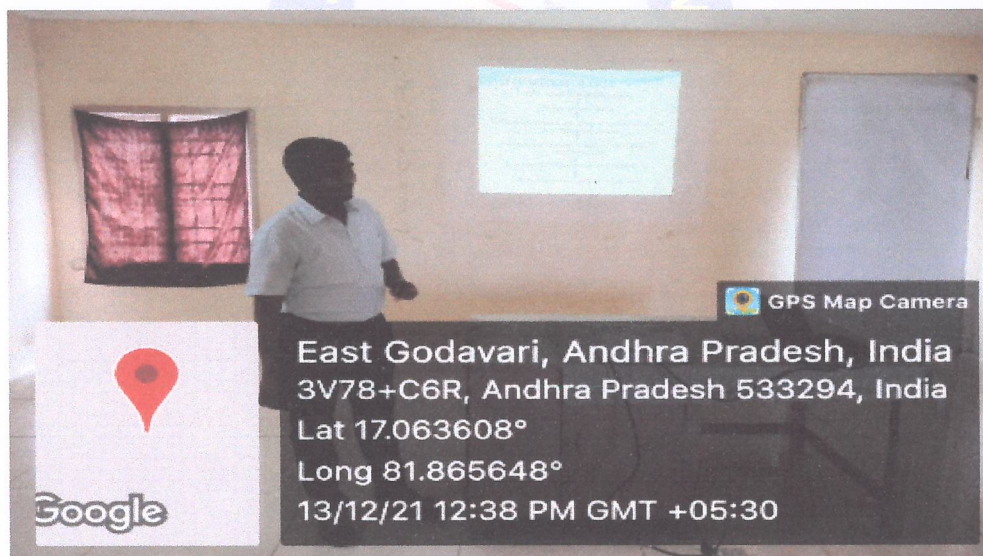


Fig. 2: Presentation on Clinical research in Hematology

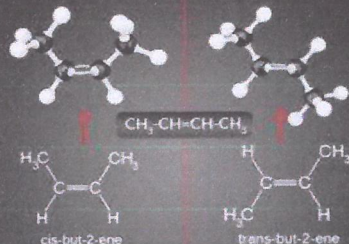
Stereochemistry is the systematic presentation of a specific field of science and technology that traditionally requires a short preliminary excursion into history.

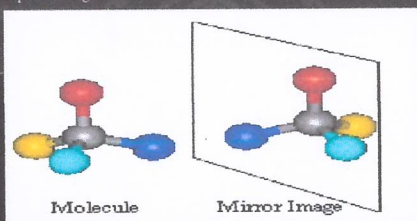
- Recognize a stereogenic (chiral) center in a molecular structure.

Enantiomers exhibit a type of stereoisomerism where the atoms have different spatial arrangements in three-dimensional space.

A **meso isomer** is one in which functional groups occur on opposite sides of a double bond. In contrast, the functional groups are on the same.



Optical isomerism is a case where the isomers display identical characteristics in terms of molecular weight as well as chemical and physical properties. However, they differ in their effect on the rotation of polarized light.

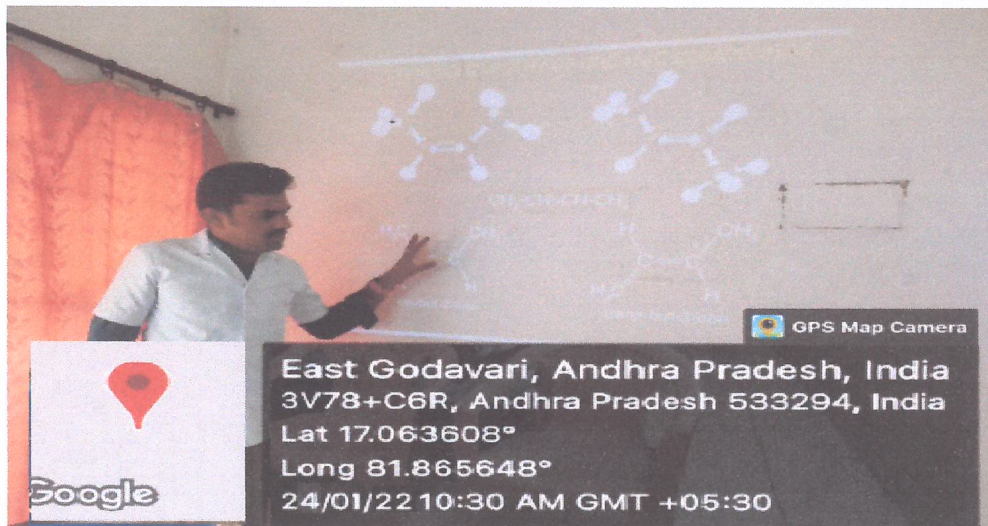


Fig. 1: Presentation on Stereochemistry of Organic compounds and its involvement in drug research

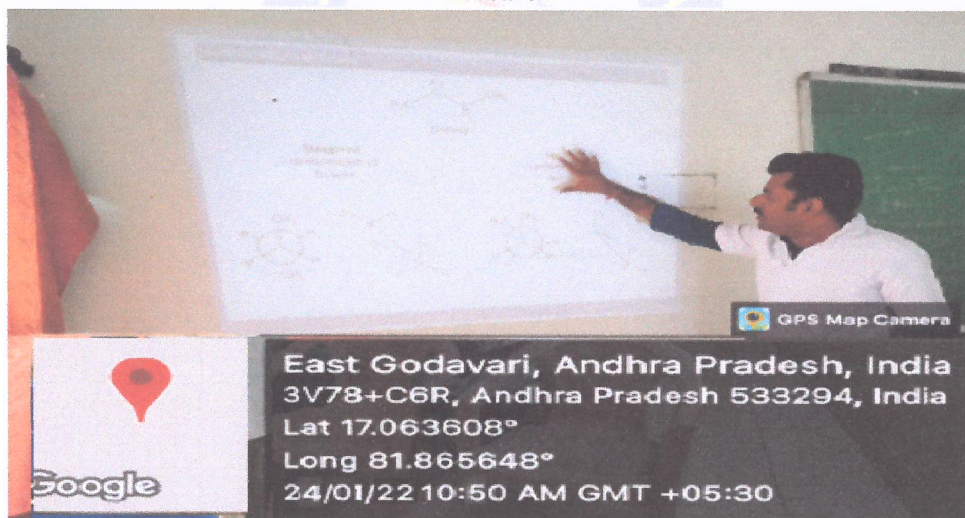


Fig. 2: Presentation on Stereochemistry of organic compounds and its involvement in drug research

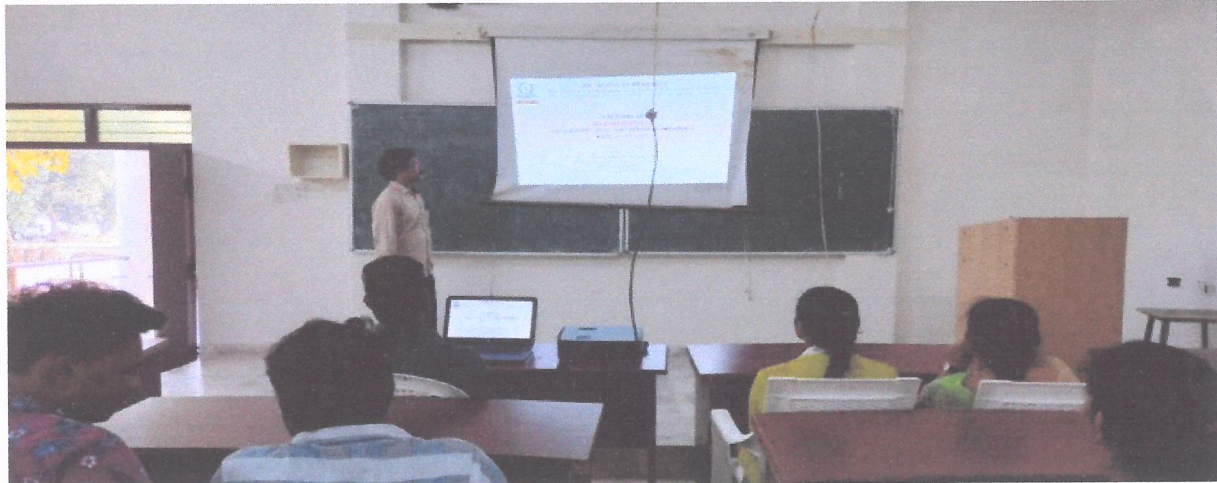


Fig. 1: Presentation on Management Skill

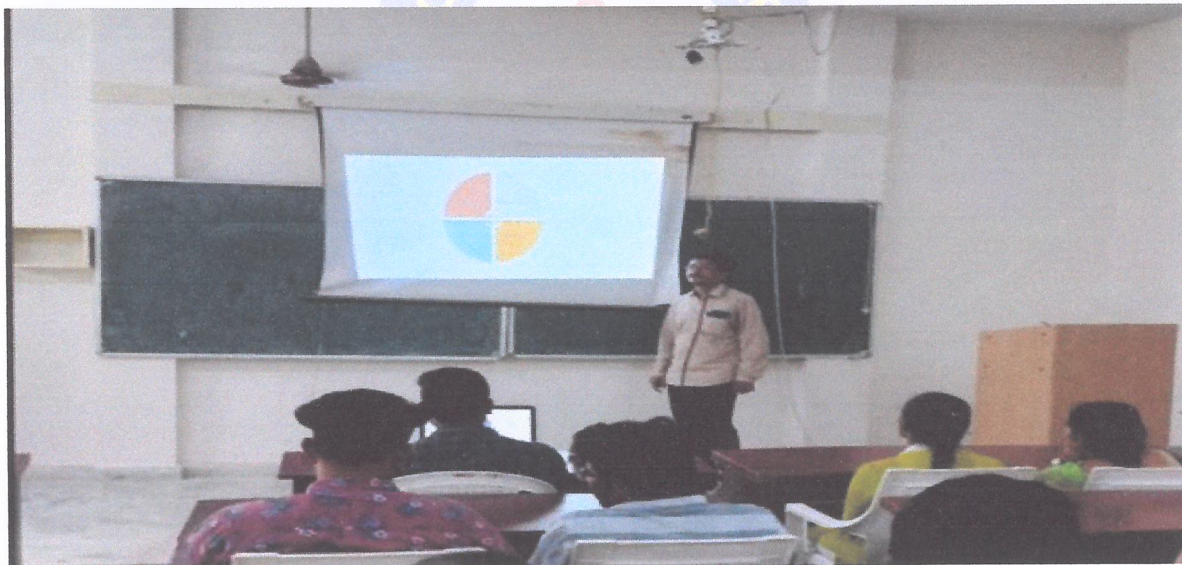


Fig. 2: Presentation on Management Skill

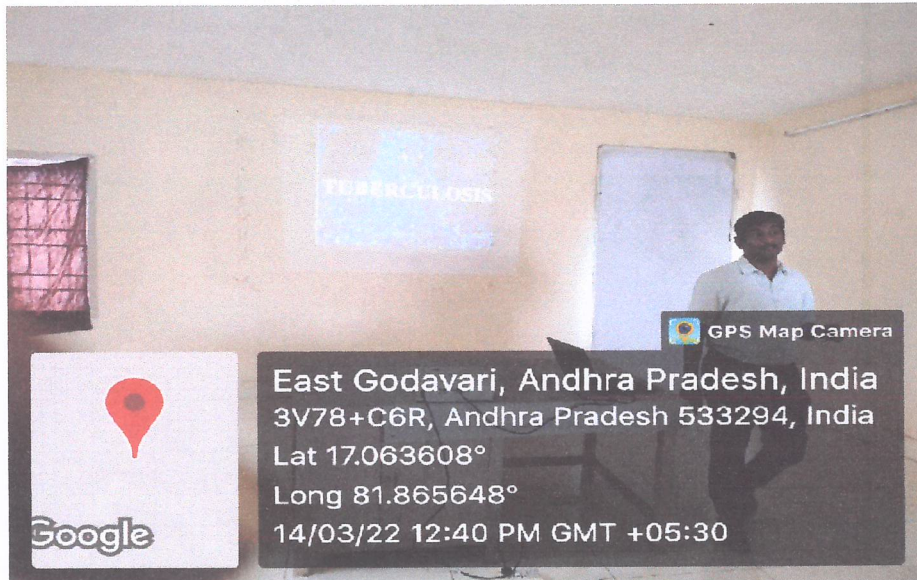


Fig. 1: Presentation on Research on Antitubercular drugs

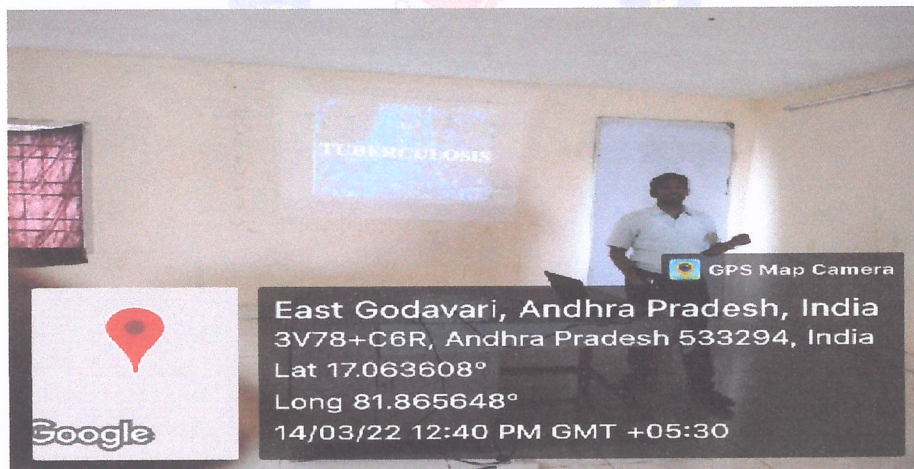


Fig. 2: Presentation on Research on Antitubercular drugs

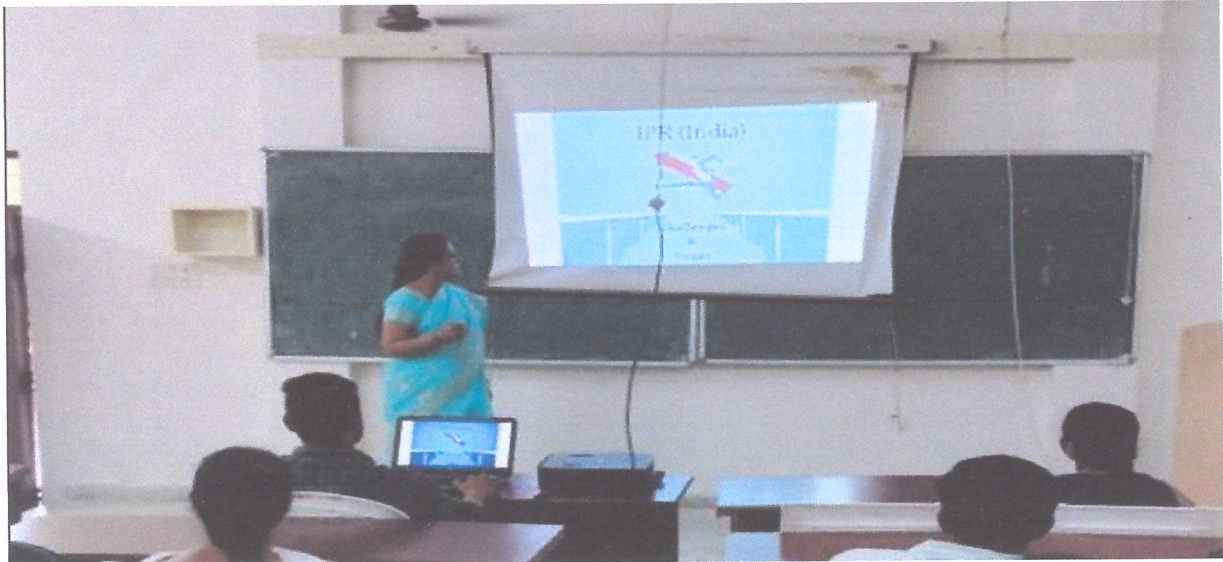


Fig. 1: Presentation on challenges in intellectual property rights

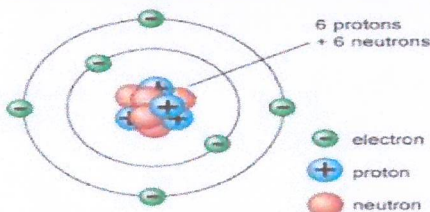

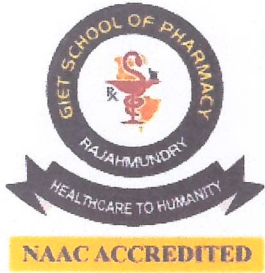
