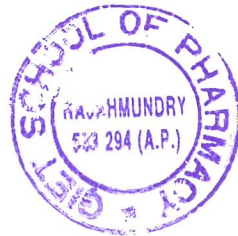

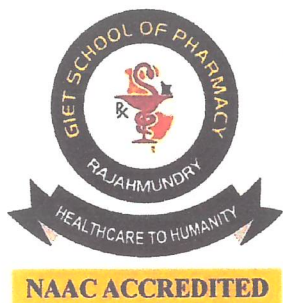

1. Objectives of the MOU are:

- A. To Promote and enhance academic interest between two institutions.
- B. To promote research and continuing education activities between institutions.

2. Technical Areas of Collaboration:

- A. Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures on recent advanced topics.
- B. Usage of academic infrastructure for students and faculty members.
- C. To facilitate the training for teachers and PG students.
- D. Guidance for enhancement in infrastructural development.

3. Proposed modes of collaborations:

Consortium institutes propose the following:

- A. Co-operation and promotion of education and training are of mutual interest.
- B. A specific plan will be worked out by the institutes depending upon availability of resources.

4. Terms and conditions:

- A. The faculty members and students can use the library on mutual basis for short time use.
- B. Both the institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short term courses.
- C. Both the institutes can exchange the faculty as resource person in order to exchange knowledge.

5. Confidentiality:

A. Consorted institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designed by the institutes as being confidential during the rendition of MOU and will not disclose the same to the third party without written consent of the other institute.

B. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information / data possessed by either institute before entering this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

6. Coordination:

A. Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching / research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf.

7. Intellectual Property Rights:

A. Institutes agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. The Intellectual property Rights that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR Policies of the two institutes.

8. Tenure and termination:

A. This MOU will be in force from the date up to **One year** it is signed by representatives of two institutions.

B. The agreement will be legitimacy for a period of 1 year from the day of signing of this agreement, until it is expressed terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, as the case may be; will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU.

C. Both the parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

9. Arbitration clause:

A. In case of dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the Directors of both the institutes will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

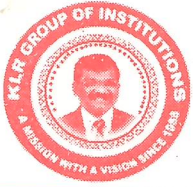

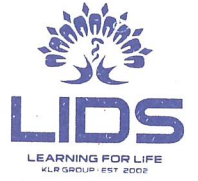

## \MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING On Academic training and cooperation between

### 1. Purpose

4 . Financial Arrangements

Both Parties understand that all financial arrangements between the Parties have to be further negotiated and mutually agreed, and will depend on the availability of funds. Both parties may seek financing of joint activities from internal and external sources available to them.

5 . Liability

Except for loss or damages caused through gross negligence or intent, the Parties shall have no liability to each other hereunder.

6 . Legal Relationship

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the Parties.

7 . Commencement, Renewal, Termination

This MoU will be effective from the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in force for a time period of one (1) year, with a possibility for renewal at the end of the period, subject to the Parties written agreement. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving two months' notice in writing to the other Party.

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

**CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance Vision and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs in developing suitable teaching and learning systems.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. ## **CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU**

- 2.1 **Teaching Learning and Evaluation:** Catering to Student Diversity and teaching / training methodologies, Review Evaluation Process and Student Performance and Learning Outcomes.
- 2.2 **Research and Development:** Both Parties must carry out the joint research activities and to create an environment for Promotion of Research.
- 2.3 **Infrastructure and Learning Resources:** To review its strength in Physical Facilities, Library, IT Infrastructure and Maintenance of Campus Infrastructure.
- 2.4 **Institutional Visits & Training:** Involve in Training Programmes for both the Parties. Both the parties will also support in Student Participation and Activities and Alumni Engagement.
- 2.5 **Governance, Leadership and Management:** Help in establishing and strengthen Governance, Leadership and Management and Internal Quality Assurance System.
- 2.6 **Institutional Values and Best Practices:** Help to assess and refine Institutional value and Best Practices.
- 2.7 **Guest Lectures & Faculty Development Programmes:** To deliver guest lecturers to the faculty and other staffs of both the parties.

## **CLAUSE 3: VALIDITY**


- 3.1 This MOU will be in force from the date upto one year, it is signed by representatives of two institutions.
