B. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information / data possessed by either institute before entering this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

6. Coordination:

A. Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching / research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf.

7. Intellectual Property Rights:

A. Institutes agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. The Intellectual property Rights that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR Policies of the two institutes.

8. Tenure and termination:

A. This MOU will be in force from the date up to **One year** it is signed by representatives of two institutions.





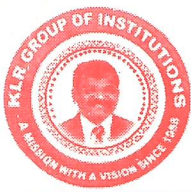

1. Purpose

6. Legal Relationship

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the Parties.

7. Commencement, Renewal, Termination

This MoU will be effective from the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in force for a time period of one (1) year, with a possibility for renewal at the end of the period, subject to the Parties written agreement. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving two months' notice in writing to the other Party.

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
various levels. The Q&A session went very well. He illustrated-through statistics that the trained faculty can work efficiently to give quality education to students.

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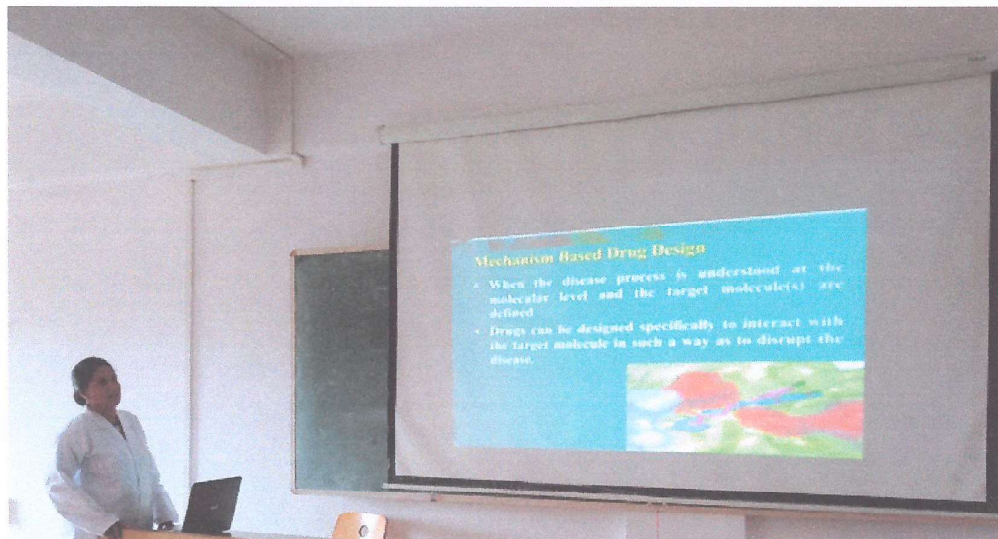


Fig. 1: Presentation on Drug design research: Molecular Modelling

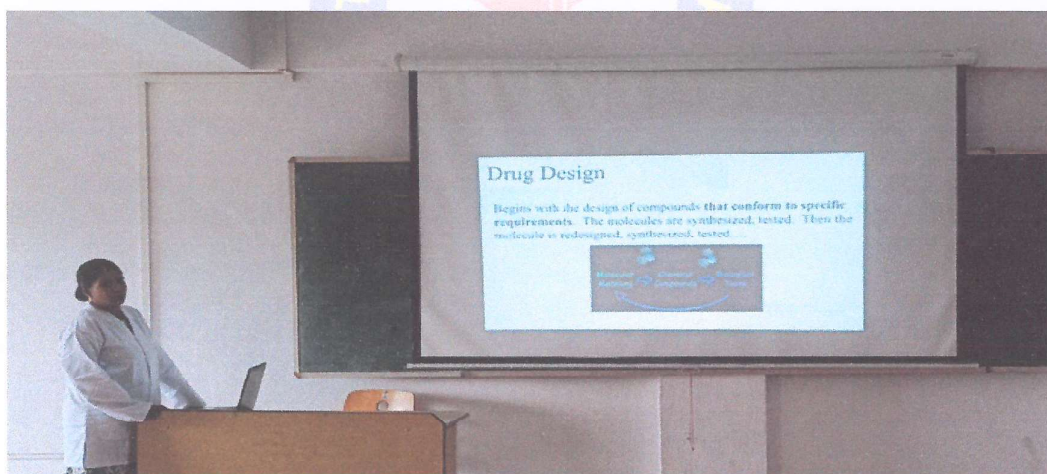



Fig. 2: Presentation on Drug design research: Molecular Modelling



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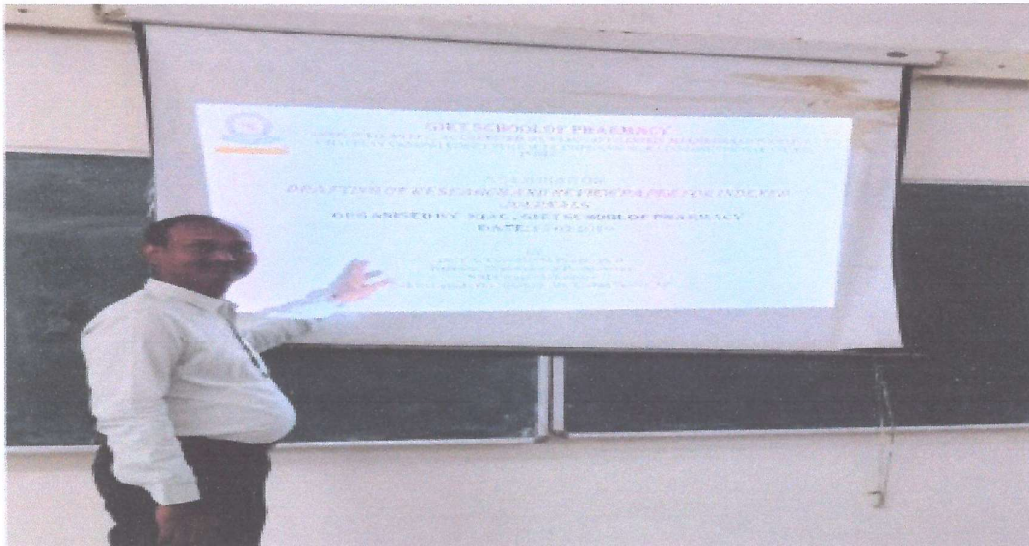


Fig. 1: Presentation on Drafting of research and review paper for indexed journals

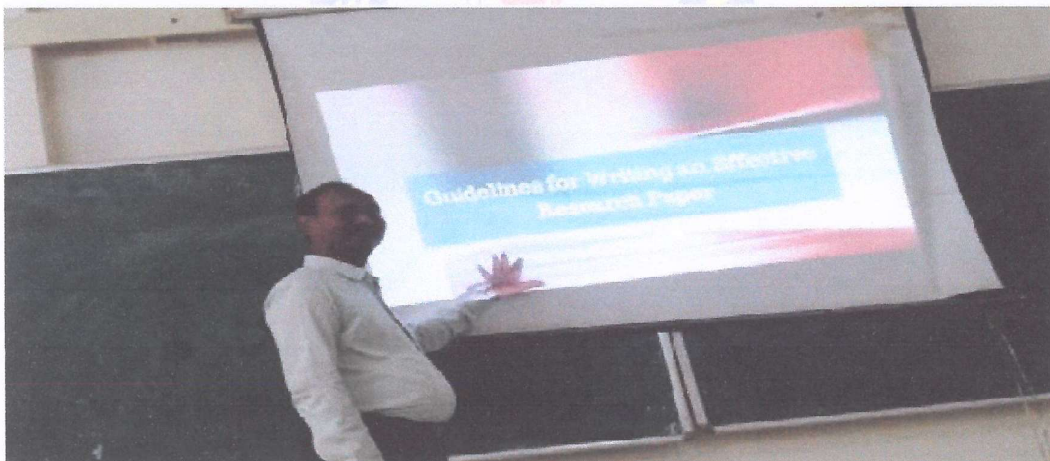


Fig. 2: Presentation on Drafting of research and review paper for indexed journals

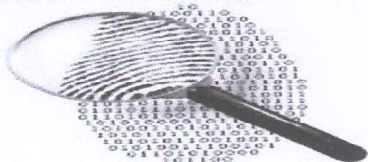
About the programme:

The research method is concerned with carrying out experiment, test, surveys, interviews, etc. As against this, research methodology is concerned with learning various techniques which can be employed in the performance of experiment, test or survey. Research method covers various investigation techniques. Research techniques refer to the behaviour (e.g. note taking) and instruments (e.g. measurement scales) we use in performing research methods. Research methodology is defined as "the science of systematically answering a research question" (PEDLAA, 2015). It refers to the entire research process.

There are four main types of Quantitative research: Descriptive, Correlational, Causal-Comparative/Quasi-Experimental, and Experimental. Research attempts to establish cause-effect relationships among the variables.

Types of research methodology
When designing a research methodology, a researcher has several decisions to make. One of the most important is which data methodology to use, qualitative, quantitative or a combination of the two. No matter the type of research, the data gathered will be as numbers or descriptions, and researchers can choose to focus on collecting words, numbers or both.

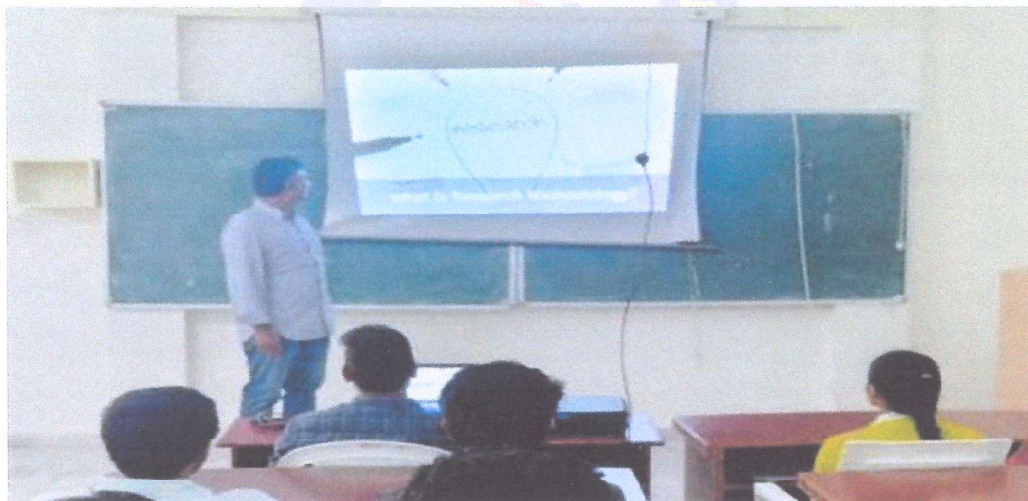


Fig. 2: Presentation on Research methodology: Method and techniques
